What's a bull's favorite school subject? Cow-culus! And at Sandy Creek Ranch, things really added up for the Faith Academy sophomores. The 10th graders were given a great field trip experience and learned many things. They were greeted with donuts and kolaches for breakfast, and then the students got to look at a variety of tools that the ranchers use on cattle and horses. The group then watched a farrier shoe a horse as he talked about the process of shoeing and how he became a farrier. The students enjoyed listening because they knew it would be a great skill to have. Next, they hopped on the back of a trailer and went out on a hayride. During the hayride, they saw all of Sandy Creek's horses, the hydroponic process of growing barley, and a traditional garden. Once they returned, the sophomores were allowed to examine Sandy Creek's hay balers and sit inside their tractor. Lunch came around and hamburgers were served, made from the ranch's own beef cattle. They were well fed and gave the burgers a high rating. After the food settled, the sophomores got to examine the cattle chute, and then each were given an opportunity to freeze brand the cattle. All who branded enjoyed it, and some had the opportunity to do it again. Afterward, the students got to look at bull sperm under a microscope to determine if the bull was good for reproduction. They were then allowed to etch their own designs on an ear tag and take it home. The hosts ended the tour by giving away five Sandy Creek hats to the students who answered the ranchers' questions correctly. The sophomores went home talking about their favorite parts of the trip. We would like to thank Quintes Stark and the other ranchers at Sandy Creek Ranch for giving these sophomores a great experience!


